Far South – nothing received. Confirmation since that last RRC that there will be a mentor for the Far South Rover Crew. Fees invoice forwarded this afternoon by RCR.

Figtree – Membership is as last meeting. A number of squires will be knighted in the next few months as squire training is being complete.

Kusi – Kusi is helping to organize the next NZ venture as Assistant Australian Contingent Leader, 550 venturers. He will undertake scout leader training and has eLearning completed with views to completing training in September.

General Business

- Service WE was postponed; rescheduling should happen soon, crews need to notify Charlotte of weekends to be avoided. 7th and 8th of September suggested as an appropriate date.
- Amy would like to know if Rovers would like to do service at Wollongong Public School clearing some land and perhaps putting in a fence. Crews should let Amy know ASAP if they would like to be involved. RCR and ARCR suggested picking a weekend and advertising it to crews, 2nd weekend of September chosen.
- A crew needs to volunteer to run Roventure so that a date can be booked for Mt Keira. Tenders will be taken next RRC.
- A list of all vannies who have resigned in the past year (35ish) has become available. Crews should use this list to recruit new members.

- Korrahill Scouts need a new leader, rovers of the region are being asked if they would like to fill this role and at the same time complete service.
- Kiama asked to form a crew a few months ago. The advice that we will give them will be to join an existing crew. Under a sponsor crew arrangement the formation of a new crew will be considered. However, new information suggests that they will join Albion Park.
- Issue raised at RA's meeting about Rovers attending AJ as service leaders and lack of information provided, an email was sent out with the requested information.

- Jamborette – Tristan spoke to the committee about running an event at Jamborette. The Jamborette organisers have indicated that if a significant number of rovers want to run a base they may, individual rovers will be slotted into established bases otherwise. There is no Branch Moot so there is no reason not to attend.

- Matters arising from BRC
 - To be a crew leader competent you must have your eLearning done by January.
 - Ryan is suggesting in response that there should be a day or two where all SCAT rovers come together to do the eLearning, a weekend at the end of October has been suggested. Also, every last Friday of the month there will be training leaders at the scout shop/region office if places are booked to complete eLearning.
 - W1, M5 and L8 need to be completed to apply for eLearning. PLA is Bob or Greg.
 - Branch moot – something radical must be done to promote it because our branch moots are very small in comparison to states like VIC. The forming of a multi region committee was suggested to organize with tenders 10-12 months in advance, and moving from October long WE to another WE or long WE.
 - Suggestions from RRC – have each region organize on a rotating basis.
 - BRC are trying to organize a bulletin and want region and crew write ups for big events to include.
 - Wal Werner
 - Hike for hunger – SydNth 200, SydS bit more than them.
 - Training costs
 - BST @ pennant hills BYO food and accommodation for \$50. eLearning \$40 – must be completed ~4 weeks before BST, also MUTE THE VOICE and multitask to minimize the pain of eLearning.
 - There are some courses coming up 22nd 23rd Sept at Pennant Hills, 24th 25th at Hunter and Coastal.
 - Next year rover BST will be done on demand.
 - M6 forms can now be submitted online.
 - SCAT is the 4th biggest region in that state, 98 in rovers, and the region is in growth.
 - Disney Cruise is coming up 12th October run by Turrumurra. Event is on Facebook.
 - Magical Mystery Tour is also coming up and is on Facebook.
- Widgame

 - We won't be doing the management for the hike for hunger cans because we can't transport them.
